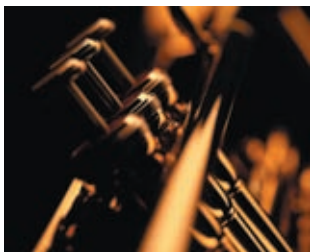

Bedroom Facilities

Balcony En-suite

The seven balcony rooms are either twin or double bedded each having wc, bath and separate shower facilities, a balcony and lounge area. A trouser press is provided in addition to normal bedroom facilities. Superior accommodation with unrivalled panoramic sea views.

Deposits

Lounge Service

Morning coffee, light lunches and afternoon teas with homemade cakes are available between 10.30am and 5.00pm by waiter service.

Swimming Pool

The outdoor swimming pool is heated throughout the Hotel season. **Parents are reminded that they are totally responsible for the safety and supervision of children at all times.**

Laundry

There is a guest laundry with washing machine/drier and having an iron and board for guest use.

Travel Arrangements

In association with a fully bonded ABTA tour operator we are able to offer a fully inclusive travel and accommodation package. Flights and ferries are always well booked in advance so it is important that as soon as possible **after** making your hotel reservation that your travel arrangements are made. Photo identification will be needed eg: driving licence / CitizenCard - full passports are only really necessary for day trips to France.

Day Trips, Excursions and Car Hire

An Island Explorer bus service now operates from outside the hotel to other parts of Jersey and a wide range of island coach tours and day excursions to the other Channel Islands and France are all easily arranged. **Passports are required for France.** A hire car provides the freedom to explore the island at your leisure. All cars are latest models and available at a low cost. **A valid driving licence is required.**

Room Availability

Sea view rooms are often available at a small supplementary cost. We regret that specific bedrooms cannot be guaranteed, only room type and facilities. Should a room change be necessary, this will be notified at the time of reservation. Every effort will be made to eliminate a room change prior to arrival.

Internet Access

Free wi-fi facilities are now available within the hotel, along with a broadband access point, computer facilities/printer near reception.
